~ LEAGUE RULES ~

We want this to be a league of golfers who love to play the game and wish to improve their skills. It is meant to be fun and challenging without being bogged down by a handicap system. We want everyone who joins this league to come every week, bring their best game and have fun. We expect each golfer to be on their honor when keeping their scores. Remember, this league is not about how much money you can win and it will benefit a greater cause.

1. 9-hole league: 5:00pm or 6:00pm tee time every Thursday (\$15.00 w/ cart); 18 holes (\$25.00).
2. Standard PGA golf rules apply, except where course rules apply.
3. All golfers will be expected to replace divots and ball marks on greens and fairways.
4. All golfers will be expected to leave the course in as good a shape as they found it in, if not in better shape. We do not want the course to be sorry they hosted our league at their course.
5. This is a single player scored league. No teams.
6. Players may play with any other league members; no set playing partners will be assigned.
7. Players will be asked to make as many weeks as possible. We know that things will come up that will not allow a player to attend every week. Please try to let us know ahead of time if you can't make it so that guys aren't waiting around to fill foursomes.
8. This is a no handicap league. Players will be ranked "A", "B", "C", or "D" based off first 4 weeks scores. Lowest 25% =A, next 25% = B and so on. Rankings will be reevaluated every 4 weeks.
9. Scoring will be on a point basis following this system: Eagle = 5 points; Birdie = 3 points; Par = 2 points; Bogie = 1 point.
10. Points: "A" Players = points times 1; "B" Players = points times 1.25; "C" Players = points X 1.5, and "D" Players = points times 1.75. The points determine league rankings.
11. There will be a \$10 weekly league fee.
12. Trophies will be given to the top 3 players and the most improved player at the end of the league.
13. There will be a Scramble at the conclusion of the league, the league will pay entry fee for all league players. Each league player will be asked to bring a foursome for the scramble; we will be raising money for our selected charity and it will be administered by The Community Foundation of Greater Lafayette (www.cfglaf.org).
14. 25% of the league fees will be added to the money collected at the scramble to be given to our selected charity.
15. Any funds not used for the scramble or given to the charity will be redistributed to league players based on points scored by each player. Total Money / Total points in league = value of each point. (Bob scores 237 points in the league. There are 5688 points in the league, \$1800 in league pool. $1800 / 5688 = 31.6$ cents per point. Bob would get back \$74.89 at the end of the league.
